The EEU of An Taisce is the national operator of a number of highly successful environmental education, sustainability and behaviour change programmes such as Green-Schools, Blue Flag, National Spring Clean, Clean Coasts and Climate Ambassador. The EEU of An Taisce works with a wide range of participant and supporters and sponsors to deliver these programmes.

An Taisce is now recruiting **1 Full Time Climate Adaptation Officer** to be located in the Dublin Region to develop and deliver a programme of transition-year workshops in the Dublin and Cork region in conjunction with the Climate Smart Team in Trinity College Dublin. The post will be full-time Monday - Friday but a degree of flexibility of working hours around evenings will be expected.

Key Responsibilities:

1. Develop, deliver and evaluate teacher training.
2. Develop, test and deliver hands-on TY climate adaptation activities.
3. Recruit schools to participate in the Climate Smart programme.
4. Run and evaluate a series of in-person TY workshops in the Dublin and Cork region.
5. Communicate effectively with schools and TY teachers and guide them through participation remotely.

6. Contribute to workshop structure and implementation, and provide support within workshop implementation, including taking notes and troubleshooting with testers.
7. Liaise with the Climate Smart Team in Trinity College, Dublin
